



Prof. Zoran Keković, PhD

Security expert

Prof. Dr. Zoran Keković is the founder and president of the Center for Risk Analysis and Crisis Management. Since 2009, he has been a full professor at the Faculty of Security at the University of Belgrade in the teaching subjects: Security Systems, Security of the National Infrastructure, and Methodology and Content of Disaster Risk Assessment and Protection and Rescue Plans. Since 2005, he pioneered the first specialist studies in the academic community of Serbia and the region in the field of crisis management at the Faculty of Security Studies. He served as Vice-Dean for Postgraduate Studies and Scientific Research at the Faculty of Security Studies since 2012 to 2016. As a visiting professor, as well as a member of university bodies and committees, he was engaged in several higher education institutions in the country and abroad (Faculty of Law, University of Novi Sad; Faculty of Political Sciences, University of Belgrade; Faculty of Security and Protection in Banja Luka; Aston University-Aston Business school, Birmingham; Warwick University in Great Britain, etc.). He is also the president of the National Commission for Standards in the Field of Security and Resilience (KS A 292) within the Institute for Standardization of Serbia. Since 2019, he has been a president of the Southeast Europe Branch of the London Institute for Strategic Risk Management. He participated in a large number of scientific research and application projects, trainings and services focusing on risk management, crisis management, business continuity management as well as critical infrastructure protection. He has been involved in drafting critical infrastructure protection legislation for the Serbian Ministry of Interior. His work bridges academic research and practical application in risk and crisis management in the corporate and public sector. He is recognized nationally and internationally as an authority in this field.

Prof. dr Zoran Keković

Prof. dr Zoran Keković je osnivač i predsednik Centra za analizu rizika i upravljanje krizam. Od 2009. godine je redovni profesor Fakulteta bezbednosti Univerziteta u Beogradu i nastavnik na predmetima: Sistemi bezbednosti, Bezbednost nacionalne infrastrukture i Metodologija izrade i sadržaj procene rizika od katastrofa i planova zaštite i spasavanja. Bio je osnivač i voditelj prvih specijalističkih studija u akademskoj zajednici Srbije i regiona iz oblasti kriznog menadžmenta, osnovanih 2005. godine na Fakultetu bezbednosti. Od 2012 do 2016. godine na Fakultetu bezbednosti obavljao je dužnost Prodekana za postdiplomske studije i naučno-istraživački rad. U svojstvu gostujućeg profesora, kao i člana univerzitetskih tela i komisija bio je angažovan na više visokoškolskih ustanova u zemlji i inostranstvu (Pravni fakultet Univerziteta u Novom Sadu, Fakultet političkih nauka Univerziteta u

Beogradu, Fakultet za bezbjednost i zaštitu u Banjoj Luci, Aston University-Aston Business school, Birmingham, Warwick University u Velikoj Britaniji, itd). Od 2007. godine je predsednik Nacionalne komisije za standarde iz oblasti bezbednosti i otpornosti (KS A 292) u okviru Instituta za standardizaciju Srbije. Od 2019. član je Londonskog Instituta za strateški menadžment rizicima i predsednik Ogranka za Jugoistočnu Evropu. Pored rada u akademskoj zajednici, Zoran Keković je učestvovao u velikom broju naučno-istraživačkih i aplikativnih projekata, stručnih obuka i usluga iz oblasti procene rizika i upravljanja rizicima, kriznog menadžmenta, menadžmenta kontinuiteta poslovanja i zaštite kritične infrastrukture. Na poziv Sektora za vanredne situacije MUP-a RS neposredno je bio angažovan na pripremi zakonske i podzakonske regulative iz oblasti zaštite kritične infrastrukture. Njegove najbliže oblasti interesovanja uključuju risk i krizni menadžment u korporativnom i javnom sektoru.
